We have succeeded in getting clearance of title for our magazine from the competent authorities and have completed all the formalities in Collector Office, Ahmedabad and addressed the authorities in New Delhi. Registration Number for magazine is awaited. Shri M.R. Vashista, our New Delhi Representative is assigned the task to pursue further.

Savingram Campaign:

The 19th Get to Gather was held on **15.05.2009, Friday**, in Himabhai Hall, Ahmedabad at 16.00 hours. Though on that the heat was 44.4 degree centigrade, we are glad to say that the hall was jam packed to its capacity. All the members showed their concern pointing out inordinate delay in finalization of 50% IDA Merger issue. Shri D.D. Mistry explained latest development on the issue and assured that if necessary, we will revert to legal action and thanked the members for showing their willingness for financial contribution in that eventuality.

However, it was decided to take further action as deemed fit and we have in addition to our exhaustive correspondence published in this issue, we have send three copies of representation to Hon. P.M. and others. Details are published elsewhere in this issue.

I.D.A. W.E.F. 01.07.2009: It works out that there is increase of 2.7%, thus making total IDA admissible to pre-retired 01.01.2007 BSNL Pensioners as 100%.and for executives increase will be 1.6%.

Administrative Charges: As you all are aware, as per resolution passed in 1st Bi-Annual Conference held at Ahmedabad on 15.05.2007, all members are required to subscriber administrative charges of Rs.50/- per each financial year to meet with expenditure of quarterly magazine, office maintenance and other activities.

We regret to say that the collection received up to 31.03.2009 is not satisfactory. In order to apprise you regarding non receipt of the same, we have published a list of members who have so far not subscribed to administrative charges.

What Shri VAN Namboodiri, GS BSNLEU, has to say for Pensioners?

BSNLEU demands five year agreement with fitment benefit not less than 30% on pay+78.2% DA The BSNL management is saying that in case of five year agreement the fitment benefit will be necessarily less than 30%. In Coal Sector the Unions accepted 24% fitment benefit for five year periodicity since it is the second wage revision after 1-1-1997, one on 1-7-2001 and another on 1-7-2006. In these two agreements, a total fitment benefit of 52.52% was achieved in Coal Sector. Since we have only one wage revision on 1-1-2007 ten years after 1-1-1997, we should achieve fitment benefit not less than 30%. **Since the top level executives in BSNL, like GM//CGM//Director etc got in effect a fitment benefit of 50 to 62% on Pay+78.2% DA, the BSNLEU is demanding the same fitment benefit for non-executives.**

In case five year period wage revision is achieved, the benefit of two wage revisions on 1-1-2007 and on 1-1-2012 shall be available to all including those retiring before 1-1-2012

Assuming that we achieve five year wage agreement with fitment benefit of 30% on Pay+78.2% in this wage revision from 1-1-2007 and assuming that we will achieve another 30% fitment benefit in the wage revision due on 1-1-2012, the total fitment on 1-1-2012, will be 60%. This total fitment benefit of 60% will be available for all the employees, including those who retire before 1-1-2012. This is because those who retire before wage revision can not be discriminated compared to those who retire after wage revision, in the matter of pension. *For example the Government has issued orders vide Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare F.No.38//37//08-P&PW((A)) dated 1-9-2008 to revise the pension of those retired before 1-1-2006 at par with those retired after 1-1-2006 by granting 40% fitment benefit to those retired before 1-1-2006, at par with the fitment benefit granted to the serving employees on 1-1-2006 as per sixth pay commission report with effect from 1-1-2006.* On the same line, the additional fitment benefit of 30% as assumed to be granted as above to those who will be in service on or after 1-1-2012 has to be granted for those retiring before 1-1-2012 also to upgrade their pension on par with those retiring after 1-1-2012. Thus there will be no discrimination between those retiring before and after 1-1-2012. On 1-1-2012, the non-executives, both retired and serving by that date, will enjoy the benefit of the two wage revisions on 1-1-2007 and on 1-1-2012, in case we achieve five year wage revision agreement.

Five year wage agreement will not create any problem regarding pension:

The management is saying that there may be difficulty in revising the pension in case wages are revised every five years, since pension for the DoT employees absorbed in BSNL is paid by the Government and since there is no five year wage revision for Government employees. This is not correct. The periodicity of wage revision implemented for Central Government employees with effect from 1-1-2006 on the basis of sixth pay commission recommendations is not decided anywhere and there is no basis for assuming it as 10 years. As per Rule-37A of pension rules, the pension for absorbed BSNL employees is to be calculated in the same manner as in the case of Government employee. It is not in any way linked with the periodicity for wage revision. Only thing is that what ever may be the periodicity of wage revision, an order has to be issued by the Government upgrading the pension of those retiring before wage revision on par with those retiring after wage revision.

Who has to issue such an order? Whether DoT can issue on its own or whether it is to be done by the Department of Pension? This is not yet decided. That is why the order for implementing the 50% DA merger with effect from 1-1-2007 for those retired before 1-1-2007 still remains unissued. Once this question is decided, there is no problem regarding periodicity of wage revision, in the matter of pension.

(Our Note: While we do not comment upon the wisdom and expertise of recognized union, we are prompted to ask that what had forced them not to consider the Pensioners at par with working employees and as to why they

have failed to incorporate pensioners interest in their repeated demands and agitational issues? This is equally applicable to other Unions who have their say and influence with the management.)

Touch & go story by BSNLEU at its proposed strike on 19.05.09 & 20.05.09

Extracts..

8) Pensionary benefits:

(a) Pensionary benefits for absorbed employees on par with Central Government Employees As per sub-rule 8 of Rule 37-A of CCS (Pension) Rules; the DoT employees absorbed in BSNL are eligible for pensionary benefits on the basis of their combined service in DoT and BSNL, as per the CCS (Pension) Rules in force at the time of superannuation. Subsequently an explanation was added to this sub-rule vide DoP&PW No. 4/61/99-P&PW dt 28-12-2002, that **the calculation shall be done in the same way as would be the case with a central Government servant retiring on superannuation on the same day.** The Government issued orders improving pensionary benefits of Central Government employees based on recommendations of the Sixth Pay Commission. Some of the improvements in the pensionary benefits as per these orders are ;

a. Full pension is to be given on completion of minimum 20 years qualifying service and pension shall be paid @ 50% of the emolument or average emoluments received during the last 10 months, whichever is beneficial, for those retired on or after 2-9-08.

b. DCRG is to be paid subject to maximum ceiling of Rs 10 lakhs for those retired on or after 1-1-2006.

c. Family pension is to be paid as per enhanced rates for the wards of those who retired or expired on or after 1-1-2006.

d. Separate orders were issued in the case of those who retired/died before 1-1-2006.

As per the rulings mentioned in Para 1 above, the pensionary benefits of DoT employees retired after absorption in BSNL (BSNL absorbed retirees) have to be revised. Further, as per the sub-rule 7 of DoP&PW order No.38/37/08-P&PWA dated 1-9-2008, on revision of pension of pre 2006 pensioners and family pensioners, the pension of Government servants absorbed in PSUs and drawing pension from the Government are to be paid pension as per these revised rules. But so far, this remains un-implemented.

For the DoT officials absorbed in BSNL and retired before completion of 10 months in IDA scales, the pension is reduced on account of wage revision from CDA to IDA scales w.e.f 1-10-2000 (due to reduction in DA rate). But this issue remains unsettled so far. In this connection it is to be noted that such a problem arising out of wage revision based on Sixth CPC recommendations w.e.f 1-1-2006 is settled by the Government vide sub-rule 12 of its order No.38/37/08-P&PW dated 2-9-2008, by taking Pay+DP+DA relevant and drawn on 1-1-2006 as emoluments for the pre-revised period. Similar benefit was extended at the time of wage revisions for Central Government employees based on 5th Pay Commission recommendations, vide DoP&PW No.45/86/97-P&PW(A)-Part-I dated 18-10-1999.

(b) Pension Scheme for BSNL Recruitess

As per sub-rule 23 of Rule-37A of CCS(Pension) Rules, the BSNL has to

devise its own pension scheme for the employees directly recruited by it and make arrangements for funding and disbursing the pensionary benefits. But so far such a pension scheme is not evolved for BSNL recruitees, even though the issue was raised by the Union several times. It is requested to see that the management immediately prepares a draft of the pension scheme for the BSNL recruitees and finalizes the same after discussion and agreement with the representative union.

(c) 50% IDA merger for pensioners ;

50% IDA was merged with pay for BSNL employees with effect from 1-1-2007. But this merger was not implemented for the pensioners who retired from BSNL. This requires urgent settlement.

OUR REPRESENTATIONS ON 50% IDA MERGER ISSUE

2. Thus, by saying retired after 01.01.2007 has created division amongst pre-retired employees of BSNL who are also equally eligible for the similar benefit, as all the PSUs have given the similar treatment to pre and post retired employees who retired from BSNL.

3. I, therefore, request you to kindly intervene and ensure justice for senior citizen who have served the Department for decades and contributed for prosperity of Govt.
4. The Executives have got their revised wages with 50% IDA Merger and non executive have been given benefit of 50% IDA Merger and six basic as advance towards their wage revision. Thus there is discrimination towards the BSNL Pensioners.

opportunity to invite your kind intervention on the captioned subject, as the case is inordinately delayed by shunting out from one department to another without any valid reason, though position is clear on the subject..

The Department of Public Enterprises vide OM No.2(7)/2005-DPE(WC)-G-III Dated 26.02.2008 conveyed to all the PSUs its sanction for merger of 50% IDA w.e.f. 01.01.2007. The Ministry of Communication & IT vide its letter No;79-38/2006-SU dated 1.5.2008, conveyed its approval for merger of 50% IDA with basic pay of the employees' of BSNL w.e.f. 1.1.2007 and DoT ND has issued the necessary orders on 24.02.2009 for retirees of 01.01.2007 depriving the BSN; Pensioners who retired prior to 01.01.2007 and thus drawing dividing line in pensioners.

Since there can not be discrimination between the Pensioners of Govt. of India and the Pensioners of BSNL who are also Govt. Pensioner, the case is clear. In light of modifying Rule 37-A, which says the BSNL Employees after their retirement will be eligible for Government Pension. The DoT has recently issued a clarification stating that responsibility of pension related issue of BSNL Retiree lies with Govt. of India. We also enclose explanatory note on the subject, explaining the judicial position on the issue.

We solicit your kind favor to cause early clarification in the matter and also to release order of 50% IDA merger for the pensioners who retired prior to 01.01.2007.

**NOTE ON 50% I.D.A. MERGER
CASE FOR PRE-RETIRES
01.01.2007 and Pension
Fixation Formula**

The Department of Public Enterprises vide OM No.2(7)/2005-DPE(WC)-G-III Dated 26.02.2008 conveyed to all the PSUs its sanction for merger of 50% IDA w.e.f. 01.01.2007. The Ministry of Communication & IT vide its letter No;79-38/2006-SU dated 1.5.2008, conveyed its approval for merger of 50% IDA with basic pay of the employees' of BSNL.

The DoT has so far not issued orders for 50% I.D.A. Merger to BSNL Pensioners who retired during the period from 01.10.2000 to 31.12.2006 and has given indifferent treatment for these Pensioners, which amounts to discrimination and violation of Article 14 of our constitution as per the land mark judgment pronounced by Five Member Bench of the Apex Court on 17.12.1982 in the case of D.S. Nakara & Others Vs Union of India in W.P. Nos: 5939-5941 of 1980. Relevant portion extracts:

Para 42: "We have set out the objects underlying the payment of pension. If the State considered it necessary to liberalize the pension scheme, we find no rational principle behind it for granting these benefits only to those who retired subsequent to the date simultaneously denying the same to those who retired prior to that date. If the liberalization was considered necessary for augmenting social security in old age to Government Servants then those who retired earlier cannot be worst off than those who retire later. Therefore, this division which classified pensioners into two classes is not based on any rational principle and if the rational

principle is the one of dividing pensioners otherwise equally placed, it would be discriminatory. **The equal treatment guaranteed in Art. 14 is wholly violated in as much as the pension rules being statutory in character, since the specified date, the rules accord differential and discriminatory treatment to equals in the matter of commutation of pensions.** A 48 hours difference in matter of retirement would have a traumatic effect. Divisions are thus both arbitrary and unprincipled. Therefore, the classification does not stand the test of Art.14.”

Para 46: “And beware that it is not a new scheme, it is only a revision of existing scheme. It is not a new retirement benefit. It is an upward revision of an existing benefit. If it was a wholly new concept, a new retirement benefit, one could have appreciated an argument that those who have already retired could not expect it. It would have been urged that it is an incentive to attract the fresh recruits. **Pension is a reward for service. It is undoubtedly a condition of service but not an incentive to attract new entrant only;** it would be prospective at such distance of thirty-five years back. Recall at this stage the method adopted when pa-scales are revised. Revised pay-scales are introduced from a certain date. All existing employees are brought on to the revised scales by adopting a theory of fitments and increments for past service. In other words, benefit of revised scale is not limited to those who enter service subsequent to the date fixed for introducing revised scales but the benefit is extended to all those in service prior to that date. This is just and fair, now if pension, as view it, is some kind of retirement wage for past service, can it be denied to those who retire earlier, revised retirement benefits

being available to future retirees only? Therefore, there is no substance in the contention that the court by its approach would be making the scheme retroactive, because it is implicit in theory of wages.”

Para 49: “All pensioners wherever they retired would be covered by the liberalized pension scheme, because the scheme is a scheme for payment of pension to a pensioner governed by 1972 Rules. **The date of retirement is irrelevant. But the revised scheme would be operative from the date mentioned in the scheme and would bring under its umbrella all existing pensioners and those who retired subsequent to that date.**”

Para 65: “That is the end of the journey, with the expanding horizons of socio-economic justice, the Socialist Republic and Welfare State which we endeavor to set upon and largely influenced by the fact that the old man who retired when emoluments were comparatively low and are exposed to vagaries of continuously rising prices, the falling value of the rupee consequent upon inflationary inputs, we are satisfied that by introducing an arbitrary eligibility criteria 'being in service and retiring subsequent to the specified date; for being eligible for the liberalized pension scheme and thereby dividing a homogeneous class, the classification being not based on any discernible rational principle and having been found wholly unrelated to the objects sought to be achieved by grant of liberalized pension and the eligibility criteria devised being thoroughly arbitrary, we are of the view that the eligibility for liberalized pension scheme of 'being in service in the specified date and retiring subsequent to that date' in impugned memoranda, violates Art. 14 and is unconstitutional and is struck down.”

Thus, in this case the cut-off date as 1.1.07 to get IDA merger is discriminatory, arbitrary and is violation of Art.14 of Constitution of India.

In a case between Society of retired Forest Officer, U.P. and State of U.P. & Others in Writ Petition No.35 of 2006, two members Division Bench of the Apex Court delivered the following judgment on 30.07.2008.

“We direct that every pensioner whether he/she is employee of Government of India, State Government, Corporation or Public Sector is entitled to pension on the beginning of every month. The respondents are directed to ensure that every incumbent should get the pension from the Bank in first week of every month. As and when there is a revision of dearness allowance and revision of pay scales then the effect of that revision should be ensured promptly and the fixation should be released as far as possible within two months of the so called revision but that revision shall not suspend the payment of pension at the old rate till it is finalized. As and when the fixation is done, the arrears should be released to the incumbent promptly within a period of two weeks.

With the above observations, the write petition is disposed of.”

The above latest judgment of the Apex Court even stipulates time limit for pension revision, DA revision. But in our case the basic order on 50% DA merger was issued by DPE on 26.02.08 and by DoT on 01.05.08. Even after one year the issue is still hanging.

Precedence in similar organizations.

BSNL was carved out of Department of Telecom. Just before

conversion on 01.10.2000, the GOI gave solemn assurance to pay pension/family pension to DoT absorbed BSNL employees under CCS Pension Rules, 1972.

Similarly FCI was carved out of Food & Agriculture Department, GOI, under an Act of Parliament in 1964. GOI assured them also to pay pension/family pension under CCS Pension Rules 1972.

These are the only two PSUs whose employees are getting pension from Government of India under CCS Pension Rules 1972. The employees of these two PSUs are getting IDA pay scale.

IDA Pensioners/family pensioners of the FCI were granted an interim relief @ 10% of their basic pension/family pension, subject to a minimum of Rs. 280/- p.m. w.e.f. 01.01.1997 onwards vide letter No: 38020/1/98-FC.3 dated 30.11.1998 of Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution Department, Government of India. This was adjusted when pension revision took place.’

Similarly 50% Dearness Relief merger to BSNL Pensioner is in a way an interim relief.

IDA pay scales were revised w.e.f. 01.01.1992 for the serving FCI Class I and II Officers and the same benefit with same date of effect was given to retired FCI Class I and II officers. Similarly for Class III and IV employees the revision of pay and pension was effected w.e.f. 01.02.1992.

FCI Employees got another pay revision w.e.f. 1.1.1997. This benefit was not extended to FCI Pensioners. This issue went before the Committee on Petitions. 8th Report of the Committee on Petitions of 14th Lok Sabha was placed on the floor of Parliament by its Chairman Shri Prabhunathsinghji on 25.05.2005.

The relevant portion of Committee's observation/recommendation is given below:

Para 1.25 :

The Committee express its displeasure over the fact that despite repeated issuance of various orders and clarifications by the Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare regarding revision of pension/family pension, the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Good & Public Distribution (Department of Food & Public Distribution), did not issue specific orders for payment of pension and other pensionary benefits in the revised scales of pay w.e.f. 1.1.1997 in order to mitigate the problems of the employees. On account of varying judgments by two High Courts in the matter, the Government has filed an SLP in the Supreme Court and the matter is still pending the Supreme Court of India.

Para 1.26

Keeping in view that SLP is now pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Committee strongly recommend that vigorous efforts should be made by the Government for an early hearing of the case in order to dispose of the matter at the earliest, so as to give relief to the pensioners. The Committee also desire that they should be apprised of the progress made in the case periodically.

Para 1.27

The Committee note that revision of Pay Scales/Pension is not under dispute and it is only the payment of Dearness Relief (DR) IN THE REVISED SCALE, WHICH IS PENDING FOR JUDGEMENT IN THE Supreme Court. The Committee accordingly recommends that till the matter is disposed of by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the petitioners may be provisionally

paid the pension in the revised scales so as to overcome their extreme financial hardship. Besides, the Committee also desires that the Government should release the payment of quarterly Dearness relief to the retirees of IDA pattern immediately which has been withheld since April, 2003 subject to a decision by the Court.

Respecting the observations/recommendations of the Committee on Petition, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food and Public Distribution issued two orders on 31.5.2005 vide No: 38020/1/2000-FC.3.

In the above said order in Para 7, it is mentioned "The matter has been considered in consultation with the Integrated Finance Division of the Department, The Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare and the Department of Legal affairs and it has been decided to regulate w.e.f. 1.1.1997 the pension/family pension of all such IDA pensioners/family pensioners in the manner indicated in the succeeding paras." (Copy attached).

In the light of the legal position pronounced by the Apex Court mentioned in the first part of this letter and the precedence of FCI quoted in the second part of this letter, we request you **to issue immediate orders for 50% DR merger with basic pension w.e.f. 1.1.2007 and the pension/family pension revision for BSNL retired employees w.e.f. 1.1.2007 extending identical weightage given to serving employees.** Since the Department of Food and Public Distribution has already consulted DOP&PW and Department of Legal Affairs on the subject, it need not again be referred to them so that further delay can be avoided. Further the Committee on Petition of 14th Lok Sabha

has expressed its displeasure over the delay by the Department of Food and Public Distribution./ We earnestly hope that DoT would issue immediate orders on the subject and avoid any such displeasure.

VI CPC has recommended pension revision for not only post 2006 retirees but also to pre 2006 retirees which was accepted by the Government and implemented.

BSNL is similar to FCI and comparable PSU. CCS Pension rules 1972 are applicable to both these organizations. In FCI, wage revision and pension revision took place w.e.f. 1.1.97.

Department of Food and Public Distribution under the Ministry of Consumer affairs, Food and Public Distribution issued an order on 31.05.05 vide No: 38020/1/2000-FC.3. In Para 7 of that letter, **it was explained how to revise the pension if 10 months average falls partly in pre-revised scale and partly post-revised scale.** Relevant portion of said letter reads:

“ In the case of employees who have retired within 10 months of their coming over to the revised scale of pay, the average emoluments shall be calculated as follows for the purpose of determining their pension entitlement.

For the period during which pay was drawn in the pre-revised pay scales The total emolument for the number for which pay was drawn in the pre revised pay scales shall be calculated after taking into account the following :-

Basic Pay (including increment, if any, drawn during the intervening period)

Actual variable dearness allowance up to AICPI 1708.

Notional increase of the basic pay by applying the fitment benefit of 20% on the basic pay in the pre-revised scales.

For the period during which pay was drawn in the revised pay scales: the aggregate of the basic pay for the number of months for which pay was drawn in the revised pay scales.

The average emoluments of the preceding 10 months will thereafter be calculated by adding (A) and (B) and dividing the result by 10. Pension admissible will consequently be 50% of the average emoluments so calculated subject to a minimum of Rs.1275/- and maximum up to 50% of the highest pay in FCI which is Rs.26,800.00 per month since 1.1.97, provided the employees concerned has rendered not less than 33 years of qualifying service which makes him/her eligible for earning full pension. Of the qualifying service is less than 33 years, the pension shall be proportionately reduced.

If an official retired on 31.1.2001 from BSNL, then he would have drawn CDA scale for 6 months and IDA scale for 4 months. As per the above formula, the benefit of VI CPC should be given for 6 months and IDA scale for four months, add both and then arrive at 10 months average. If the FCI formula is applied, then it would reduce the loss of pension.

We request you to consider the case of BSNL Pensioners at par with the FCI guidelines as it also follows CDA Pattern and Government Pension.

We write to invite your kind attention to our letter No:BSNL /PEN/IDA/Merger dated 25.07.08, addressed to Shri Sidhartha Behura, Secretary, DoT, Sanchar Bhawan, Ashoka Road, New Delhi 110001 with a copy to you on the captioned subject. The said communication was with reference to our letters dated 25.7.08, 11.12.08 and 27.03.2009.

While enclosing our detailed notes on the subject separately constitutionally justifying our say, we furnish the brief history of the case for your perusal and immediate intervention.

The Department of Public Enterprises vide OM No.2(7)/2005-DPE(WC)-G-III Dated 26.02.2008 conveyed to all the PSUs its sanction for

merger of 50% IDA w.e.f. 01.01.2007. The Ministry of Communication & IT vide its letter No;79-38/2006-SU dated 1.5.2008, conveyed its approval for merger of 50% IDA with basic pay of the employees' of BSNL w.e.f. 1.1.2007 depriving the BSNL Pensioners who retired during the period from 1.10.2000 to 31.12.2006. **At that time we were assured that orders for left out category will be issued expeditiously. We are pained to know that there is no progress in the case and the BSNL Pensioners who also senior citizens are suffering heavily.**

Secondly, we have come to know that the DoT Cell offices from India have referred a case to you seeking further clarificatory orders **for the officials** who retired after 01.01.2007. But their cases could not be settled for those pensioners who retired from 10.01.2007 to 31.08.2007, as their pension gets reduced which not the spirit of the orders. Their calculation sheet is divided into two spells for calculation of average emoluments viz. first spell up to December 2006 and second from January, 2007 to date of retirement which results in reduction of Pension.

The Government of India, Ministry of Finance, New Delhi vide F.No. 105/1/2004-IC dated 01.03.2004, while ordering merger of 50% of Dearness Relief with basic pay/pension to Central Government Employees/Pensioners w.e.f. 01.04.2004. The operative portion of its relevant Para is reproduced below:

“3. To ensure that pensioners retiring between 1.4.2004 to 31.1.2005 do not face any loss in fixation of pension, as a special dispensation in their case, DA equal to 50% of the basic pay would be treated basic pay for purpose of computation of pension in respect of basic pay received by

them prior to 1.4.2004. Consequently element of dearness pension will exist only for pensioners retired/retiring from government of India up to 31.3.2004.”

Since there is no discrimination between the Pensioners of Govt. of India and the Pensioners of BSNL who are also Govt. Pensioner, the said provision is attracted in their case. We have also enclosed detailed note on the above to intervene.

We therefore solicit your kind favor to intervene and cause early issuance of 50% IDA merger for the pensioners who retired prior to 01.01.2007.

Orders for pre-01.01.2007 BSNL Retirees
as the matter is delayed beyond normal
permissible limit. Extracts from his letter
reads:

**VI CPC has recommended
pension revision for not only post 2006
retirees but also to pre 2006 retirees
which was accepted by the Government
and implemented.**

BSNL is similar to FCI and
comparable PSU. CCS Pension rules 1972
are applicable to both these organizations.
In FCI, wage revision and pension revision
took place w.e.f. 1.1.97.

**Department of Food and Public
Distribution under the Ministry of
Consumer affairs, Food and Public
Distribution issued an order on 31.05.05
vide No: 38020/1/2000-FC.3. In Para 7 of
that letter, it was explained how to revise
the pension if 10 months average falls
partly in pre-revised scale and partly
post-revised scale. Relevant portion of
said letter reads :**

“ In the case of employees who have
retired within 10 months of their coming
over to the revised scale of pay, the average
emoluments shall be calculated as follows
for the purpose of determining their pension
entitlement.

(A) For the period during which pay was
drawn in the pre-revised pay scales

The total emolument for the number for which pay was drawn in the pre revised pay scales shall be calculated after taking into account the following :-

- i) Basic Pay (including increment, if any, drawn during the intervening period)
 - ii) Actual variable dearness allowance up to AICPI 1708.
 - iii) Notional increase of the basic pay by applying the fitment benefit of 20% on the basic pay in the pre-revised scales.
- (B) For the period during which pay was drawn in the revised pay scales: the aggregate of the basic pay for the number of months for which pay was drawn in the revised pay scales.

The average emoluments of the preceding 10 months will thereafter be calculated by adding (A) and (B) and dividing the result by 10. Pension admissible will consequently be 50% of the average emoluments so calculated subject to a minimum of Rs.1275/- and maximum up to 50% of the highest pay in FCI which is Rs.26,800.00 per month since 1.1.97, provided the employees concerned has rendered not less than 33 years of qualifying service which makes him/her eligible for earning full pension. Of the qualifying service is less than 33 years, the pension shall be proportionately reduced.

If an official retired on 31.1.2001 from BSNL, then he would have drawn CDA scale for 6 months and IDA scale for 4 months. As per the above formula, the benefit of VI CPC should be given for 6 months and IDA scale for four months, add both and then arrive at 10 months average. If the FCI formula is applied, then it would reduce the loss of pension. We request you to consider the case of BSNL Pensioners at far with the FIC guidelines as it also follows CDA

Pattern and Government Pension.
